

## "AUDITION COACHING"

Candidates are prepared for every aspect of the audition process with my "Audition Coaching". We carefully consider your castability and strengths in order to find monologues that contrast and show your range, as well as edit them to the differing time limits set by different institutions. It is important to selects pieces that are strong enough to "stand alone" as well as fully prepare introductions to give essential context and setting to aid the audition panel to view your performance favourably.

Beyond the usual work on dynamic staging/blocking, character development, text analysis, physicalisation and vocal technique, we also work on preparing a succinct summary of all your performance and production experience that you can draw on in the interview. In this way, you are able to cite examples in response to the audition panel's questions that relate to anything from classical texts, ensemble work, new writing, contemporary plays, musicals, physical theatre – that you've either performed in or seen.

In order to back up this "industry" knowledge and awareness, we also prepare questions to ask of each institution, evidencing that you have carefully researched the course, alumni and faculty. With thousands of applicants vying for limited places, you have to show that you are the best fit for that particular institution and are eager to walk through their doors for your training or worthy to receive that scholarship/bursary.
